

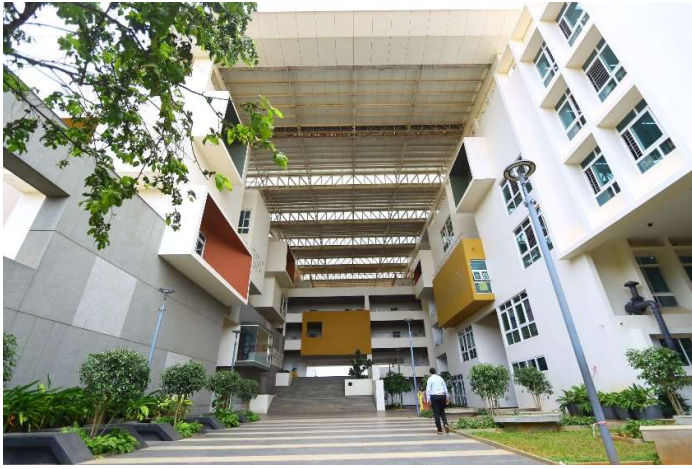

Established in 2002, Delhi Public School Bangalore North has a breathtaking 40 acre campus. The vast area provides a picture perfect ambience for an aesthetically chartered school building. The open lawns and lush greenery are marked with a colourful bonanza of fresh floral bounty, providing the perfect setting outside the din of the city limits, for the overall development of our students.

Administrative Block

This self-contained block at the entrance of the school caters to all needs such as admissions, fee payment, transport, books, uniforms etc.

Academic Blocks

The Academic blocks at DPS Bangalore North are designed as per t h e NEP 2020. Mithila Block-KG to grade 2, Vikramashika block Grade 3 to 5, Takhashila block -Grade 6 to 8, Nalanda Block Grade 9 to 12. The blocks are named on ancient universities of India. All our blocks have spacious, well lit and ventilated classrooms with LCD monitors and projectors. There are open spaces designed for learning outside the class rooms in all the blocks.

Resource Centre/ Auditorium/ Conference Hall

The school has a number of resource centers & auditoriums which are used for multiple purposes - assemblies, exhibitions, indoor activities and games.

Inclusive Practices at DPS BN

DPSBN is known across the country for its commitment towards inclusion. Our admission policy reflects our core belief that diversity in the classroom strengthens the learning experience for all. We welcome students with different physical, intellectual, emotional, social, and linguistic needs, provided they are school ready and able to benefit from our larger inclusive setup. This includes children with learning disabilities, physical impairments, low vision, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), and other developmental or medical needs. We offer Early Intervention (EI), Shadow Teacher support, Guided learning facilities, Teaching aids, Extended Curricular Support (ECS), Vocational Training, Counselling – Individual & Group, Inclusive Sports, Peer Educator Programme, Occupational Therapy

Our Libraries have a variety of books on various subjects. To inculcate good reading habits in children, programmes like DEAR (Drop Everything And Read), Story Telling Sessions, Meeting the author, Scholastic Book Club, Book Week fest, etc., form an integral part of the library.

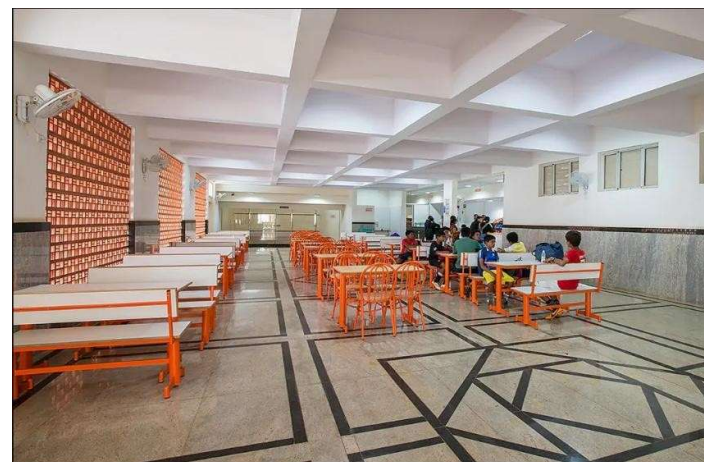
Infirmary

Amphitheatre

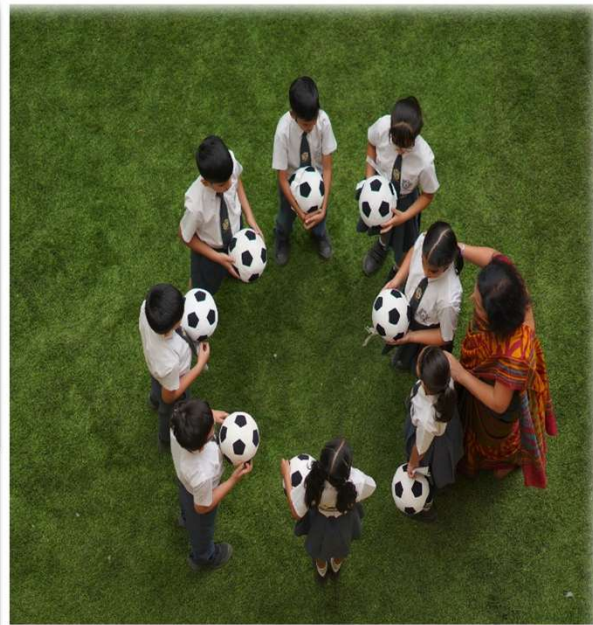
The aesthetic amphitheatres provides out door space for children to gather for various performances and activities.

Assembly Area/ Basketball Court

A plethora of activities ranging from class assemblies, to sports and practices for different events like Annual Days, interschool competitions and many more such events are organized in this area.

Butterfly Park/ Gardens/ Orchards

Sustainability is deeply rooted in the school's ecosystem. The school takes pride in its beautiful butterfly park which is home to many indigenous varieties of butterflies and insects, scenic gardens and orchards which gives plenty of opportunities for experiential learning, where students and teachers learn to de-stress, unwind and relearn together.



Swimming Pool

The school has an indoor and outdoor swimming pool of international standards where students with aquatic talents practice during and after school hours.

Playground

The School has two large playgrounds for cricket, football, track and field events. The KG block has its own outdoor and indoor play area.

Tennis Court

International standard tennis courts are used by both junior and senior students where coaches ensure that young budding tennis players find the right atmosphere to develop their sporting talent.



Science Labs

Multiple Science labs are well- designed and well- equipped with latest facilities with all the safety measures in place. Skilled teachers and lab assistants help students to use these labs efficiently

Math Lab (Logical Lab)

Math labs are computerized and also have manipulatives like geometrical figures, geo boards etc. to help the students understand the mathematical concepts in a better way.



Social Science Lab

Well-equipped Social Science lab gives the students a conducive and favourable environment to study the subject. Books related to the subject, models, maps, globe, paintings, sketches, artefacts and a smart board make the learning and teaching process interesting.



Home Science Lab

The well-equipped Home Science lab is a bright, airy, well lit room that provides the perfect ambience to address practical nuances of healthy and scientific living. Keeping health and hygiene as our topmost priority, the students are guided on how to create magic with food, keeping it healthy and tasty at the same time.

Computer Labs

The school has five well equipped state-of-the-art Computer Labs to cater to students of all grades.

Our school actively participates in various outreach and crowdfunding programs, aiming to make a positive impact on society and instill a sense of civic duty in our students.

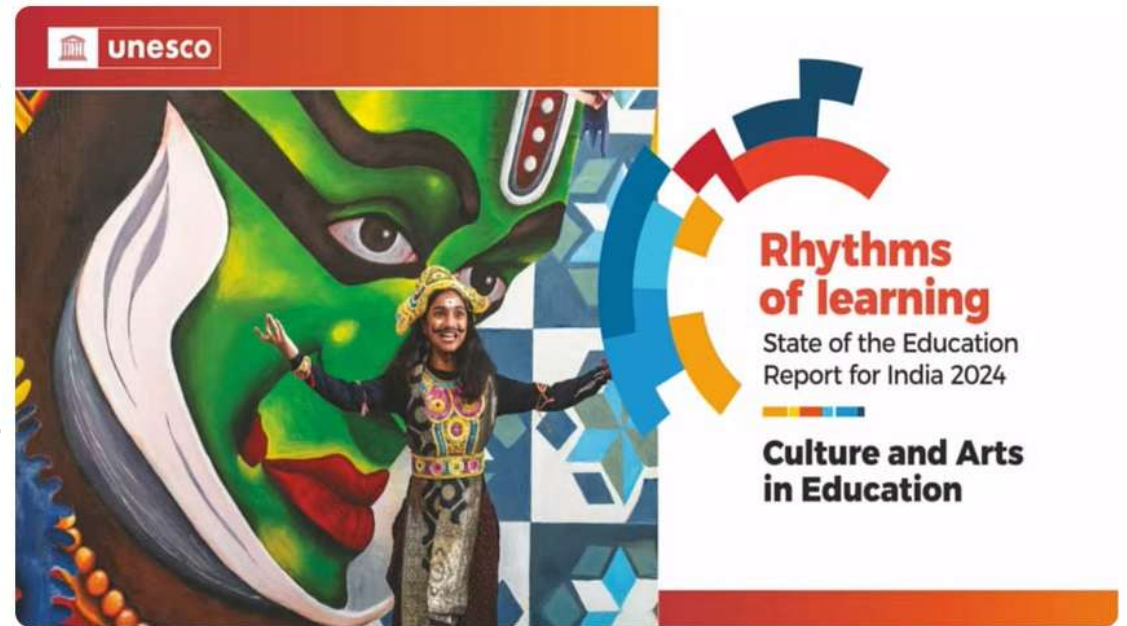
Trips and Excursions

The school provides facilities for specialized coaching through skilled and qualified coaches in various games and sports. Outdoor games like Athletics, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Kabaddi, Swimming, Tennis, Skating, Throw Ball and Volleyball are popular among the students. Indoor Sports like Badminton, Chess, Gymnastics and Table Tennis are enjoyed by students throughout the year. After school hours, special coaching is provided to school teams in all areas of sports.

Taekwondo is offered to all students. A special programme for self defense has also been curated for girls from grade 5 to 10

NCC

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high school, colleges and universities all over India. NCC is also offered at Class XI and XII as a subject.

NCC theory, drills and parades are introduced to 8th std. children. School hosts state level NCC camps. The school offers Army and Air wing.





Innovative E-learning

A world acclaimed technology integrated program for teaching and learning in classrooms in grades I to XII through Smart Class is designed to empower teachers with technology right inside the classroom. Digital resources such as animation, graphics, images and video clippings are used to revolutionize the learning process.

ENTRAR - School Management Software

Delhi Public School, Bangalore - North believes in being environmentally friendly by following the 4Rs - Refuse, Reduce, Reuse Recycle. To reduce the usage of paper in the school campus, we send all circulars, newsletters, and report cards through ENTRAR. Each parent is provided with an ID and password that allows them to access all the information. The ENTRAR - app can be downloaded on any mobile phone which gives notification for all uploads done by the school.



Registration & Admission Process Nursery to Class IX & XI

The application form must be obtained from school office or can be downloaded from our website and the same must be filled and submitted to the Administrative office. Children must fulfil the minimum age criteria laid down by the school as on 1st June of the session to which admission is being sought. There will be a written evaluation for students seeking admission to class XI.

Only those candidates who clear, will be called for interaction. During interaction, presence of both the parents is required.

Along with the duly filled application form, all the relevant documents mentioned in registration form need to be submitted to the Administration Office at the time of Registration.
